It's that time of year again! Snow is blowing, the wind is howling, and we're snug in our homes with visions of tomato plants dancing in our heads. But in two months we will open up the greenhouse and start our spring planting. Once again we are offering you the chance to pre order your spring seedlings to pick up at our Spring Open House the weekend of May 18th and 19th. Placing orders for seedlings now helps us properly allocate our limited greenhouse space and assures that you will get the seedlings of your choice.

Our seedlings are raised on the farm in our licensed greenhouse, the same varieties we grow for the farm. As farmers our livelihood depends on the seedlings we grow, so you can be confident that our seedlings are healthy, vigorous, and disease free. We are committed to sustainable growing practices, using only certified organic potting soil and fertilizer and non-GMO seeds sourced from trusted seed companies. We choose varieties with good taste and quality that grow well in this region, including many organic and heirloom varieties. We time our seeding schedule so that seedlings are hardened off and ready to plant when you get them. For best results, plan to transplant your seedlings as soon as possible after pick-up.

New this year, we have decided to start all our seedlings in peat pots, the same pots our cucumbers, melons and squashes have always been offered in. These pots can be planted right in the ground, which greatly reduces seedling transplant shock. They add organic matter to the soil and most importantly, there's no plastic trash! In future years we are hoping to start our seedlings in soil blocks, which require no pots and produce the healthiest seedlings of all. (Check out our soil block trials at the open house). With this switch to peat pots we have adjusted our seedling price. All seedlings will be \$1.50 each. We also have some new varieties, have added potatoes and sweet potatoes to the list, and by popular demand, we are offering seed packs for those things which are better sown by seed then transplanted. The seeds are from our main supplier, Fedco Seeds in Clinton Maine. All these items can be picked up along with your seedlings at the Spring Open House.

Below you will find a list of the flower, herb and vegetable varieties we are offering.. **Each variety name contains a link to our seed supplier's website which will describe the variety and show you a picture of it.** If there is a variety you are looking for but do not see, please let us know! (If there is sufficient interest, we'll add it to our crop list.) Due to limited greenhouse space we strongly encourage you to order as soon as possible. **Seed and potato varieties often get back ordered so these items must be ordered by February 15th!
